2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Approving in prospect the subleas-
6 ing by the Cities of Nome, Cordova,
7 and Unalaska from the State of
8 Alaska of certain public buildings.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Legislature has approved Senate Bill No. 198, as
11 amended by the Conference Committee, and the bill has now been
12 returned to the Governor for signature; and

13 WHEREAS under the provisions of the bill a political sub-
14 division of the state, upon meeting certain conditions, may
15 sublease from the State of Alaska public buildings financed, de-
16 signed, constructed, and acquired by the Alaska State Housing
17 Authority and leased to the State of Alaska; and

18 WHEREAS one of the requisites for eligibility of a political
19 subdivision of the state is the passage by the Legislature of a
20 concurrent resolution approving the sublease or lease;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that, subject to the fulfillment of the other
22 conditions set forth in Senate Bill No. 198, amended, as further
23 amended in the Conference Committee Report adopted by the Legis-
24 lature, the Legislature hereby gives its approval to subleases
25 between the State of Alaska and the following political subdivi-
26 sions of the state for the following projects if leased by the
27 State of Alaska from the Alaska State Housing Authority, provided
28 that the projects do not exceed the amounts specified below:
