2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 17

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the silting of the
6 bottom of the Haines small boat
7 harbor.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, some silting of the bottom of the Haines small boat
10 harbor is apparently caused by tidal action or other forces
11 operating from the seaward side of the harbor; and

12 WHEREAS, the harbor depth must be sufficient to accommodate
13 fishing vessels operating in nearby waters; and

14 WHEREAS, an earlier study of this problem was planned but
15 never accomplished;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, is
17 requested to study the feasibility of preventing the seaward
18 silting of this basin, and, further, to accomplish such work if
19 it is found to be feasible; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be directed
21 to the Honorable Pat McNamara, Chairman, Senate Committee on
22 Public Works; the Honorable Charles A. Buckley, Chairman, House
23 Committee on Public Works; the Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary
24 of the Army; Lt. General Walter K. Wilson, Chief of Engineers,
25 U. S. Army; Brigadier General Peter C. Hyzer, North Pacific
26 Division Engineer, Corps of Engineers; Colonel Clare D. Farley,
27 District Engineer, Alaska; and the members of the Alaska Delega-
28 tion in Congress.
