2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 20

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the  
6 state constitution to provide  
7 that an act rejected by referen-  
8 dum may not be re-enacted within  
9 two years after its rejection.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 6, Article XI, Constitution of the State of Alaska,  
12 is amended to read:

13 "Section 6. If the majority of votes cast on the propo-  
14 sition favor its adoption, the initiated measure is enacted.  
15 If a majority of the votes cast on the proposition favor  
16 the rejection of an act referred, it is rejected. The  
17 secretary of state shall certify the election returns. An  
18 initiated law becomes effective ninety days after certifica-  
19 tion, is not subject to veto, and may not be repealed by the  
20 legislature within two years of its effective date. It may  
21 be amended at any time. An act rejected by referendum is  
22 void thirty days after certification and may not be re-enacted  
23 by the legislature within two years after its rejection.  
24 Additional procedures for the initiative and referendum may  
25 be prescribed by law.";

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed be-  
28 fore the voters of the state at the next statewide election in  
29 conformity with Section 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State
