SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 33
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to improving the post office
facilities at Wainwright, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the post office facilities at Wainwright, Alaska are
in a dilapidated and unsafe condition; and

WHEREAS the post office lacks heat which makes working
conditions considerably burdensome and unhealthy; and

WHEREAS the post office lacks space for convenient storage
and efficient distribution of the mail;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General of the United
States is respectfully urged to take immediate steps to improve
the post office facility at Wainwright, Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
the Honorable John A. Gronouski, Postmaster General; and the
members of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
