SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 35

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to financing and con-
structing a center for the Cook
Inlet Native Association.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the Cook Inlet Native Association has begun pro-
ceedings to obtain money pursuant to the "Economic Opportunity
Act of 1964"; and

WHEREAS, the money obtained will be used to construct a
Native Culture, Social and Guidance Center in Anchorage, Alaska;
and

WHEREAS, such a facility is urgently needed to assist
Natives from outlying areas to adjust from a subsistence economy
to a wage economy, which adjustment involves profound changes in
educational requirements, skills, and social patterns; and

WHEREAS, the successful adjustment of the Alaska Native to
the new economy is vital to the well-being of the state and the
United States, as well as to the Native;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature expresses its support of
the project and urges that the requests of the Cook Inlet Native
Association be given favorable consideration; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
the Director, Office of Economic Opportunity, and the members of
the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
