10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the Cook Inlet Native Association has begun pro-  
12 ceedings to obtain money pursuant to the "Economic Opportunity  
13 Act of 1964"; and

14 WHEREAS the money obtained will be used to construct a  
15 Native Culture, Social and Guidance Center in Anchorage, Alaska;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS such a facility is urgently needed to assist  
18 Natives from outlying areas to adjust from a subsistence economy  
19 to a wage economy, which adjustment involves profound changes in  
20 educational requirements, skills, and social patterns; and

21 WHEREAS the successful adjustment of the Alaska Native to  
22 the new economy is vital to the well-being of the state and the  
23 United States, as well as to the Native;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature expresses its support of  
25 the project and urges that the requests of the Cook Inlet Native  
26 Association for a Native Culture, Social and Guidance Center be  
27 given favorable consideration; and be it

28 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
29 the Director, Office of Economic Opportunity, and the members of
