2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 43

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Commending C. L. Sainsbury of
6 the U.S. Geological Survey.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS exploring the vast untapped mineral resources of
9 Alaska is a monumental task which requires the tireless efforts of
10 extremely dedicated and highly skilled men; and

11 WHEREAS C. L. Sainsbury, Project Chief with the Branch of
12 Base and Ferrous Metals of the United States Geological Survey,
13 exhibited these commendable qualities during his mineral explora-
14 tions in the regions of Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS as a result of his efforts, C. L. Sainsbury made the
16 first substantial discovery of beryllium deposits in Alaska near
17 the Lost River; and

18 WHEREAS this particular deposit is believed to have the high-
19 est grade ore of its kind in the entire United States; and

20 WHEREAS due to the possible role of beryllium in the future
21 development of nuclear devices, the potential value of his dis-
22 covery is immense, not only to Alaska but to the rest of the
23 United States as well;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Alaska commends C. L.
25 Sainsbury for his skilled efforts, his dedication and his major
26 discovery; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
28 Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the Honor-
29 able Thomas Nolan, Director of the United States Geological Survey;
