8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS exploring the vast untapped mineral resources of
10 Alaska is a monumental task which requires the tireless efforts
11 of extremely dedicated and highly skilled men; and

12 WHEREAS John J. Mulligan, Mining Engineer with the United
13 States Bureau of Mines, is exhibiting these commendable qualities
14 during his explorations of the Seward Peninsula in Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS as a result of the efforts of John J. Mulligan,
16 important deposits of tin, beryllium and fluorite found on the
17 Seward Peninsula are now being developed; and
