4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Endorsing S. 1091, now before
6 Congress, which relates to the
7 exploration and development of
8 the continental shelf.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the members of the Alaska Legislature are familiar
11 with Senator Bartlett's bill (S. 1091) which proposes a positive
12 program for the exploration and economic development of the
13 physical, chemical, geological and biological resources of the
14 continental shelf; and

15 WHEREAS the Alaska Legislature is aware of the startling
16 discoveries of rich and extensive mineral and other resources on
17 the continental shelf which have been made in recent years; and

18 WHEREAS the Alaska Legislature believes that the potential
19 economic value of the enormous resources awaiting exploration on
20 the shelf is of such magnitude as to compel the adoption of the
21 program made possible by S. 1091;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Alaska strongly
23 endorses S. 1091 and urges the Congress of the United States now
24 assembled to take appropriate action to insure its prompt passage;
25 and be it
