2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 62

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Urging the construction of a  
6 road from Yakutat Airport to the  
7 Lower Situk River.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a road from the Yakutat Airport to the Lower Situk  
10 River would permit access to an area of plentiful game and sport  
11 fish; and

12 WHEREAS timber development is expected to bring an influx of  
13 population to the Yakutat area in the near future, with an in-  
14 creased need for recreational facilities; and

15 WHEREAS the U. S. Forest Service has already made a rough  
16 preliminary survey of a bridge and four miles of access road in  
17 this area; and

18 WHEREAS the Bellingham Canning Company has promised to assist  
19 in the construction of such a road by making a piledriver avail-  
20 able and selling piling and other timbers at cost;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. Forest Service is urged to  
22 request funds and provide necessary technical assistance for the  
23 construction of a road from Yakutat Airport to the Lower Situk  
24 River; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
26 the Honorable Orville S. Freeman, Secretary of Agriculture; the  
27 Honorable Edward P. Cliff, Chief of the U. S. Forest Service; the  
28 Honorable W. H. Johnson, Regional Forester (Alaska); and the
