SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 65
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the naming of a
mountain in Alaska in memory of
John Fitzgerald Kennedy.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS it would be appropriate for this state to establish
a lasting tribute to the memory of John Fitzgerald Kennedy, 35th
President of the United States, in order that future generations
may be reminded of his selfless service to his country, his fine
qualities as a man, and his talents as a leader of men; and

WHEREAS the naming of a towering peak in Alaska will serve
as a timeless tribute by Alaskans and other Americans to this man
whose loss to the world is still so keenly mourned;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature requests the State
Geographic Board to select and name a mountain in Alaska appro-
priate in grandeur to honor the memory of John Fitzgerald Kennedy
and to petition the United States Geographic Board for official
designation of the mountain so named; and be it
