2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 68

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Protesting the decision of the  
6 Civil Aeronautics Board regarding  
7 air service between Alaska and  
8 Seattle.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Civil Aeronautics Board has announced a drastic  
11 curtailment of air service between Alaska and the rest of the  
12 Nation via Seattle; and

13 WHEREAS the State of Alaska, through its Legislature and  
14 Governor, has long been on record for more rather than less air  
15 service to connect it with its sister states; and

16 WHEREAS the latest decision of the Civil Aeronautics Board  
17 will drastically curtail service to Alaska in general and to  
18 Southeast Alaska in particular where Pan American World Airways,  
19 which pioneered inter-state service for that region, will be  
20 denied its stops at Ketchikan and Juneau; and

21 WHEREAS the decision also includes a denial of the direct  
22 flight between Fairbanks and Seattle to Alaska Airlines;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska  
24 protests the decision of the Civil Aeronautics Board regarding  
25 Alaska - Seattle service and urgently requests the Board to re-  
26 consider and withdraw its decision; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
28 the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States;  
29 the Honorable Alan S. Boyd, Chairman, and the members of the Civil  
SJR 68

1 Aeronautics Board; and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the  
2 Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph  
3 J. Rivers, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation  
4 in Congress.
