2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 74

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting navigational aids
6 for the entrance to the
7 Kasilof River.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS boat owners using the entrance to the Kasilof River
10 have petitioned the 17th Coast Guard District for navigational
11 aids; and

12 WHEREAS the lack of navigational aids has caused great
13 damage and threatened lives of persons trying to navigate in
14 those dangerous waters but the requested aids have not been
15 installed; and

16 WHEREAS the Kenai Peninsula Fishermen's Cooperative Associa-
17 tion has endorsed the installation of navigational aids as
18 necessary to the economy of the area and those using those waters;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, is
20 respectfully and earnestly urged to direct the 17th Coast Guard
21 District to install necessary navigational aids at the entrance
22 to the Kasilof River.
