2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 76

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to experimental plants for
6 manufacturing fish protein con-
7 centrate.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Honorable E. L. Bartlett, United States Senator
10 from Alaska, has introduced in the United States Senate a bill
11 which would authorize the Secretary of the Interior to contract
12 with private firms to construct and operate large scale experi-
13 mental plants manufacturing fish protein concentrate; and

14 WHEREAS fish concentrate provides far more protein than other
15 foods and can be produced at less cost; and

16 WHEREAS lack of protein is a prime cause of malnutrition; and

17 WHEREAS fish protein concentrate therefore promises to be
18 exceptionally effective in overcoming the malnutrition and the
19 effects of malnutrition which afflict a large portion of the world
20 population;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature endorses Senator
22 Bartlett's bill and urges the United States Congress to act
23 favorably on it.
