2 **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 89**

3 **IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA**

4 **FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION**

5 Relating to the improvement of the
6 Bureau of Indian Affairs school at
7 Unalakleet and the establishment of
8 a Bureau of Indian Affairs school
9 at Hooper Bay.

10 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

11 **WHEREAS** the Bureau of Indian Affairs school at Unalakleet now
12 provides schooling only through the tenth year; and

13 **WHEREAS** an extension of the school program at the Unalakleet
14 school through the twelfth year and a corresponding expansion of
15 the curriculum is necessary to afford adequate education to the
16 children at Unalakleet; and

17 **WHEREAS** there is presently no high school at Hooper Bay even
18 though there are enough children in the area to warrant the
19 establishment of a high school educational facility; and

20 **WHEREAS** it is imperative that the children in both of these
21 areas receive a high school education;

22 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Secretary of the Interior is urgently
23 requested to make the Bureau of Indian Affairs school at
24 Unalakleet a 12-year school and to expand its curriculum accord-
25 ingly; and be it

26 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Secretary of the Interior is
27 urgently requested to establish a Bureau of Indian Affairs high
28 school at Hooper Bay.
