4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the appointment of an
6 Alaskan as Assistant Secretary of
7 the Interior for Public Land
8 Management.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS at least one-fifth of the lands owned by the United
11 States and administered by the Department of the Interior are
12 located within the State of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS no Alaskan holds a position of authority under the
14 Secretary of the Interior; and

15 WHEREAS the position of Assistant Secretary of the Interior
16 for Public Land Management is now open for appointment and one or
17 more eminently qualified Alaskans have been mentioned for that
18 appointment;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the United States and
20 the Secretary of the Interior are urged to appoint a qualified
21 Alaskan, knowledgeable of all Alaska, as Assistant Secretary of
22 the Interior for Public Land Management to assist on policy
23 determinations for the administration of the vast resources of
24 Alaska and the Nation; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
26 the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States;
27 the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the
28 Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of the State of Alaska; and
