7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS there is a lack of comprehensive information regard-
9 ing the extent of rehabilitation and remodeling which is required
10 to bring the rural schools in the state up to an adequate standard;
11 and

12 WHEREAS there is also a lack of detailed information regard-
13 ing the maintenance problems associated with the operation of
14 rural schools; and

15 WHEREAS without this comprehensive and detailed information
16 it is difficult to accurately determine the budgetary require-
17 ments needed to insure the efficient operation and sufficiency
18 of these schools;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council, in cooperation
20 with the Department of Public Works and the Department of Education,
21 is directed to evaluate the needs of the rural schools in the
22 state and to present to the Legislature, in January, 1966, a study
23 which suggests programs for the necessary restoration of rural
24 schools and the estimated costs for implementing these programs,
25 and analyzes the maintenance problems and the associated costs
26 incurred in the operation of these schools.
