5 Relating to the Delta Junction
6 School.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS the Fourth Class City of Delta Junction has a publi
9 school with grades from one through ten and the Department of
10 Education has suggested consolidation of administration with the
11 public school at Fort Greely; and

12 WHEREAS it has been intimated that a former proposal of mak-
13 ing the Delta Junction School a four-year high school may be
14 abrogated and that it is possible that the tenth grade may be
15 moved to Fort Greely, causing hardship of traveling the ten miles
16 for students and bringing dissatisfaction in the community;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Education shelve any
18 plan to place Delta Junction students at the Fort Greely School
19 and that positive plans be made and budgeted for the installation
20 of an eleventh grade class at Delta Junction in the fiscal year
21 1966-67 and a twelfth grade class in 1967-68, and that construc-
22 tion of necessary facilities be planned to commence not later
23 than July 1, 1967; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to
25 the Honorable William T. Zahradnicek, Commissioner of the Depart-
26 ment of Education, for his guidance.
