5 Directing the construction of a
6 highway from Savonoski to King
7 Salmon to develop the tourism
8 potential of the Bristol Bay
9 area.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

11 WHEREAS the general area of Bristol Bay has a great potential
12 for attracting tourists and those who enjoy hunting and fishing;
13 and

14 WHEREAS the development of this potential is dependent upon
15 the increase of tourist access to the region; and

16 WHEREAS a road across the Alaska Peninsula connecting Katmai
17 and King Salmon and linking up with the ferry service to and from
18 Kodiak Island provided by the M/V TUSTUMENA is the most feasible
19 way to open up the area to tourism and basic economic development;
20 and

21 WHEREAS there is already a road connection towards King
22 Salmon extending from Katmai to Savonoski;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Highways is directed to
24 construct a road from Savonoski to King Salmon thus providing a
25 road across the Alaska Peninsula which will make possible the
26 development of the great tourism potential of the Bristol Bay
27 area.
