5 Supporting an effort to improve the
6 status of the Department of State
7 office dealing with international
8 fishery problems.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS there is an increasing need to strengthen the United
11 States position in the field of international fisheries; and

12 WHEREAS the United States fishery problems on the high seas
13 are becoming more numerous as our coastal and distant waters
14 fisheries develop and expand; and

15 WHEREAS the present status of the Office of the Special
16 Assistant to the Under Secretary of State is not adequate to meet
17 the international fishery problems of the future; and

18 WHEREAS a meeting has been called by U. S. Senators E. L.
19 Bartlett and Warren G. Magnuson between the Secretary of State and
20 Congressional and industry representatives interested in the United
21 States fisheries, to review the problem;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of the
23 State of Alaska expresses support for strengthening the Office of
24 the Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of State and wishes
25 every success for the Congressional meeting with the Secretary of
26 State and industry representatives to resolve the problem.
