5 Expressing support for the  
6 Alaska delegation appearing be-  
7 fore Congress on Alaska native  
8 housing legislation

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS the Congress now has before it S. 1915, a bill  
11 authorizing a housing program for Alaska natives sponsored by the  
12 Honorable E. L. Bartlett, senior U. S. Senator from Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS S.1915 would establish a loan and grant housing pro-  
14 gram specifically designed for Alaska's remote villages and thus  
15 fulfill a desperate need for village housing without parallel in  
16 the nation; and

17 WHEREAS a delegation of Alaskans will be in Washington, D. C.  
18 to testify in support of this vital legislation before the Housing  
19 Subcommittee of the Senate Banking and Currency Committee;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of the  
21 State of Alaska expresses its full support for the delegation of  
22 Alaskans appearing before Congress on behalf of S. 1915, a bill  
23 authorizing a desperately needed housing program for Alaskan  
24 natives, and urges that S. 1915 receive the expeditious approval  
25 of Congress.
