7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS Senator Brad Phillips has seen fit to violate the  
9 provisions of AS 24.20.260 which governs the release of the  
10 recommendations, comments, and narrative statement of a report of  
11 the Legislative Audit Committee and the rules of the Audit Com-  
12 mittee implementing that law; and

13 WHEREAS a report has been adopted recommending censure of  
14 Senator Phillips for this violation of his trust as a member of  
15 the Senate; and

16 WHEREAS the Senator has used partisan politics to further  
17 his own personal political ends in total disregard of the law and  
18 rules which he was pledged to uphold;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that Senator Brad Phillips be, and hereby is  
20 censured for his improper and unseemingly actions in revealing  
21 confidential staff reports and thereby endangered the status and  
22 future of the Legislative Audit Committee which has in the past,  
23 under the law and rule regarding confidential inquiry, saved the  
24 State of Alaska hundreds of thousands of dollars; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be spread upon the  
26 Journal of the Senate for the record and that this censure stand  
27 against Senator Brad Phillips during the remainder of this  
28 session of the Senate.  
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
