5 Requesting a study as to the
6 feasibility of constructing
7 dormitories at Valdez, Nenana,
8 Dillingham and King Salmon.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS there are many children who are eligible to attend
11 high school but who have no school facilities available to them;
12 and

13 WHEREAS construction of school facilities at the home towns
14 of these children is not economically or educationally sound; and

15 WHEREAS there are existing school facilities which could offer
16 educational services to these children if boarding facilities were
17 available; and

18 WHEREAS Valdez, Nenana, Dillingham and King Salmon appear to
19 have the necessary school facilities and are so centrally located
20 that if dormitory facilities are constructed, many children
21 presently denied educational services could be provided the train-
22 ing to which they are entitled;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
24 Department of Education to study the feasibility of constructing
25 dormitories and other boarding facilities at Valdez, Nenana,
26 Dillingham and King Salmon and to submit a report of the study to
27 the Legislature by January 1967.
