5 Relating to the expenses incurred by
6 state employees while traveling on
7 state business.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS in the course of their employment many employees of
10 the state are required to travel on official business; and

11 WHEREAS it is provided by law and regulation that an employee
12 is reimbursed for necessary expenses incidental to his travel in
13 the form of per diem; and

14 WHEREAS it often happens that an employee required to travel
15 is in effect required to assume some of the otherwise reimbursable
16 travel costs because of the interpretation of the law or regu-
17 lation by the department concerned; and

18 WHEREAS it was not the intent of the Legislature in providing
19 for reimbursement for necessary official travel to place an
20 additional burden on the state employee and require that he bear
21 that financial burden as a condition of employment;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to
23 direct the Department of Administration and all other state agen-
24 cies to make any necessary revision of state travel regulations
25 and departmental policies to that end that no employee traveling
26 on state business may be required as a condition of employment to
27 travel partly at his own expense.

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
