6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a public lands advisory committee;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 30. PUBLIC LANDS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

11 Sec. 38.30.010. CREATION OF COMMITTEE. There is created a Public
12 Lands Advisory Committee to represent and enunciate the State of
13 Alaska's position on public lands with other states and before the
14 Federal Land Law Review Commission, and to advise the governor and the
15 legislature on federal and state public land laws, policies and
16 problems.

17 Sec. 38.30.020. MEMBERSHIP OF COMMITTEE. The committee consists
18 of nine members, three ex officio and six appointed by the governor and
19 confirmed by the legislature. The ex officio members are the attorney
20 general, who serves as chairman, the director of the division of lands,
21 and the commissioner of revenue. The appointed members shall represent
22 the natural resource industries (fishing, mining and timber), local
23 government, banking, organized labor, and the general public.

24 Sec. 38.30.030. MEETINGS AND REPORTS. The committee shall meet
25 at least twice a year and subject to the call of the chairman. The
26 committee shall make an annual report of findings and recommendations
27 to the governor and the legislature and may make special reports at
28 any time.

29 Sec. 38.30.040. EXPENSES. The expenses of the committee shall

be covered in an appropriation made for that purpose to the department of law. Appointed members are entitled to the transportation and per diem allowances provided for state board members by general law.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1967.
