BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.20.520 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 11.20.520. INJURY TO ANIMALS OR OTHER PERSONALTY. (a) A

person who, without legal excuse or justification, acting with gross

12

negligence or with intent to adversely affect the well-being of the

13

animal but without malice, kills, wounds, disfigures or injures an

14

animal which is the property of another, or who administers or exposes

15

poison to the animal, with the intent that it be taken by the animal,

16

and without the consent of the owner, or who, by means not specified

17

in this chapter, destroys or injures personal property of another is

18

guilty of a misdemeanor.

(b) A person who maliciously kills, wounds, disfigures or injures

20

an animal which is the property of another, or who maliciously adminis-

21

ters or exposes poison to the animal, with the intent that it be taken

22

by the animal, or who maliciously, by means not specified in this

23

chapter, destroys or injures personal property of another, is guilty

24

of a felony and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not

25

less than six months nor more than three years, or by a fine of not

26

less than \$150 nor more than \$1500.
