6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual and sick leave of state
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20.240 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.240. ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE. The annual leave
11 which is not used by an officer or employee accumulates for use in
12 succeeding years until it totals not to exceed 60 days at the end of
13 the [LAST COMPLETE MONTHLY PAY PERIOD IN A] calendar year.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260(e) is amended to read:

15 (e) Upon his separation from state service, and unless he
16 re-enters employment of the state within six months of his termination,
17 the unused sick leave of an officer or employee is automatically
18 cancelled without pay for it. If an employee when terminated by the
19 state re-enters the state service within six months after his termina-
20 tion he is entitled to credit for one half of the sick leave he had
21 accrued at the time of his termination.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
23 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
