6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications for veterans'
7 loans; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 26.15.130(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 Sec. 26.15.130. ELIGIBILITY FOR LOANS. (a) Qualifications for
11 loans under this chapter are:

12 (1) persons who served in the armed forces of the United
13 States for 90 days or more, part of which [OR WHOSE] service was [FOR
14 LESS THAN 90 DAYS BECAUSE OF INJURY OR DISABILITY INCURRED IN THE LINE
15 OF DUTY,] between April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, [AND] Septem-
16 ber 16, 1940, and July 25, 1947, June 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955,
17 or August 4, 1964 and six months after termination of hostilities in-
18 volving forces of the United States in Vietnam, or whose service was
19 for less than 90 days because of injury or disability incurred in the
20 line of duty between any of these dates, and who were separated from
21 the armed forces with a discharge other than dishonorable, and (A) who,
22 at the time of induction into the service, were residents of the
23 territory, who had been residents for not less than one year immedi-
24 ately before their induction, and who returned to the territory or
25 state after discharge as residents with the intention of remaining in
26 the territory or state; or (B) who, not being bona fide residents of
27 the territory before their entry into the service, have lived in the
28 territory or state for at least 10 years following their release from
29 active military service;
