6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to transportation of school children.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.09.010(c) is amended to read:

9 (c) The school board of a district, or the department for areas
10 not within school districts, shall designate as hazardous those routes
11 which cannot be safely traveled by children not served by school bus.
12 The designation may recognize hazards that exist only part of the time
13 and in these instances the designation shall be applicable only during
14 the time the hazards are found to exist. The board or the department
15 shall provide for the transportation of pupils on routes designated
16 as hazardous. The pupil residence which is more than eight miles from
17 the school of attendance is on a hazardous route, and the board or the
18 department shall provide for the transportation or for remuneration for
19 the transportation of pupils living this distance from school. The
20 additional cost of the transportation in a district shall be shared
21 equally by the district and the department. Eligibility to receive
22 school bus service on routes designated as hazardous shall not be
23 subject to restrictions based on the minimum distance between established
24 schools and the residences of pupils.
