6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the occupation of barbering; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.12.075. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE. A person is entitled  
11 to be licensed as a barber who meets the requirements of sec. 320 of  
12 this chapter.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

14 ARTICLE 6. APPRENTICE BARBERS.

15 Sec. 08.12.300. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE OF APPRENTICE BARBER.

16 To be entitled to be licensed as an apprentice barber a person must  
17 have

18 (1) educational requirements specified by this chapter or by  
19 regulations of the board;

20 (2) completed a course of study and training in, and re-  
21 ceived a diploma from, an approved barber college in the state;

22 (3) applied to the board for an examination within six  
23 months from the date of graduation from the approved barber college;

24 (4) passed an examination given by the board.

25 Sec. 08.12.310. FAILURE TO PASS OR APPLY FOR EXAMINATION. An  
26 applicant who fails an examination or fails to apply for an examination  
27 within six months of the time he graduates from an approved barber  
28 college must re-enroll in an approved barber college and pass further  
29 courses specified by the board.

1           **Sec. 08.12.320. ENTITLEMENT TO EXAMINATION AND LICENSURE AS A**  
2 **BARBER.** An apprentice barber is entitled to take an examination,  
3 prescribed by the board, and, if he passes it, to be licensed as a  
4 barber after he has served as an apprentice barber for not less than  
5 two years under the immediate personal supervision of a licensed  
6 barber. If he fails the examination, he must practice as an apprentice  
7 barber for six months before he may apply for another examination.

8           **Sec. 08.12.330. AFFIDAVIT.** An apprentice barber shall file an  
9 affidavit with the board at the end of each six months for a two-year  
10 period from the date he is licensed as an apprentice barber. Only one  
11 apprentice barber shall be employed in any licensed barber shop. No  
12 apprentice barber shall be allowed to barber for more than three years  
13 on an apprentice barber license. The board may revoke or suspend the  
14 license of a licensed barber who refuses to sign a true affidavit, and  
15 may sign the affidavit in the place of the barber. An apprentice  
16 barber who does not file the affidavit may not take the examination.

17                   **ARTICLE 7. BARBER SHOP LICENSE.**

18           **Sec. 08.12.350. LICENSE REQUIRED.** No person may own or operate  
19 a barber shop the operation of which begins after the effective date  
20 of this section without its having been inspected and licensed by the  
21 board.

22           **Sec. 08.12.360. REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSURE.** No barber shop may  
23 be licensed until it complies with the requirements of this chapter  
24 and the regulations of the board.

25           **Sec. 08.12.370. TIME FOR ISSUING LICENSE.** No license to operate  
26 a barber shop may be issued for at least a reasonable time after  
27 application is made for it.

28           **Sec. 08.12.380. PERMITS ISSUED.** No permits will be issued to  
29 any out-of-state journeymen barbers until they take and pass the

Sec. 08.12.115. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBER SHOP. The annual fee for a license to operate a barber shop is \$25.

\* Sec. 6. AS 08.12.180 and 08.12.270 are repealed.

\* Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1967.
