6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the occupation of barbering; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.12.075. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE. A person is entitled
11 to be licensed as a barber who meets the requirements of sec. 320 of
12 this chapter.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

14 ARTICLE 6. APPRENTICE BARBERS.

15 Sec. 08.12.300. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE OF APPRENTICE BARBER.

16 To be entitled to be licensed as an apprentice barber a person must

- 17 (1) be 16 years of age or over;
18 (2) meet the health requirements of sec. 70 of this chapter;
19 (3) meet the educational requirements specified by this

20 chapter or by regulations of the board.

21 Sec. 08.12.310. FAILURE TO PASS OR APPLY FOR EXAMINATION. An
22 applicant who fails an examination or fails to apply for an examination
23 within six months of the time he graduates from an approved barber
24 college must re-enroll in an approved barber college and pass further
25 courses specified by the board.

26 Sec. 08.12.320. ENTITLEMENT TO EXAMINATION AND LICENSURE AS A
27 BARBER. (a) An apprentice barber is entitled to take an examination
28 prescribed by the board if he

- 29 (1) has completed a course of study and training in, and

1 received a diploma from, a barber college approved by the board and has
2 served not less than six months as an apprentice barber under the
3 immediate supervision of a licensed barber and has applied to the
4 board for an examination within six months from the date of graduation
5 from the barber college, or

6 (2) has not completed a course of study described in (a)(1)
7 of this section but has served not less than 24 months as an apprentice
8 barber under the immediate supervision of a licensed barber.

9 (b) If the apprentice passes the examination, he is entitled to
10 be licensed as a barber. If he fails the examination, he must practice
11 as an apprentice barber for six months before he may apply for another
12 examination.

13 Sec. 08.12.330. AFFIDAVIT. An apprentice barber shall file an
14 affidavit with the board at the end of each six months for a two-year
15 period from the date he is licensed as an apprentice barber. Only one
16 apprentice barber shall be employed in any licensed barber shop. No
17 apprentice barber shall be allowed to barber for more than three years
18 on an apprentice barber license. The board may revoke or suspend the
19 license of a licensed barber who refuses to sign a true affidavit, and
20 may sign the affidavit in the place of the barber. An apprentice
21 barber who does not file the affidavit may not take the examination.

22 ARTICLE 7. BARBER SHOP LICENSE.

23 Sec. 08.12.350. LICENSE REQUIRED. No person may own or operate
24 a barber shop the operation of which begins after the effective date
25 of this section without its having been inspected and licensed by the
26 board.

27 Sec. 08.12.360. REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSURE. No barber shop may
28 be licensed until it complies with the requirements of this chapter
29 and the regulations of the board.

Sec. 08.12.090. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBERS AND APPRENTICE BARBERS.

The annual fee for a license to engage in barbering or apprentice barbering is \$25 [\$10].

* Sec. 5. AS 08.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.12.115. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBER SHOP. The annual fee for a license to operate a barber shop is \$25.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1967.
