6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the occupation of barbering; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.12.080 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (3) examination for apprentice barber license. . . . \$25

11 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.12.090 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 08.12.090. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBERS AND APPRENTICE BARBERS.

13 The annual fee for a license to engage in barbering or apprentice  
14 barbering is \$25 [\$10].

15 \* Sec. 3. AS 08.12.120 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 08.12.120. LICENSES. Licenses shall be issued by the board  
17 to any applicant who meets the requirements under sec. 320 of this  
18 chapter [PASSES THE EXAMINATION AND WHO POSSESSES THE OTHER NECESSARY  
19 QUALIFICATIONS]. Each license and temporary permit shall have a photo-  
20 graph of the licensee attached.

21 \* Sec. 4. AS 08.12.160 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 08.12.160. TEMPORARY PERMIT. Any person entering the state  
23 or transferring from a practice exempt under the provisions of sec. 270  
24 of this chapter, and who desires to engage in barbering who has [(1)  
25 A DIPLOMA FROM A BARBER COLLEGE ACCREDITED BY THE BOARD OR (2)] a bona  
26 fide license issued by another territory or state, which territory or  
27 state has substantially the same requirements for licensing as this  
28 state, shall not be required to serve an apprenticeship but shall be  
29 issued a temporary permit and may be required to pass an examination

1 prior to being issued a license [SHALL BE ISSUED A TEMPORARY PERMIT,  
2 VALID UNTIL THE NEXT EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD].

3 \* Sec. 5. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

4 ARTICLE 6. APPRENTICE BARBERS.

5 Sec. 08.12.300. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSING APPRENTICE BARBERS.

6 To be entitled to be licensed as an apprentice barber a person must have

7 (1) educational requirements specified by regulations of  
8 the board;

9 (2) completed a course of study and training in, and received  
10 a diploma from, a barber college approved by the board;

11 (3) applied to the board for an examination within two years  
12 from the date of graduation from the approved barber college or from  
13 the date of completion of the educational requirements specified by  
14 the board; and

15 (4) passed an apprentice examination given by the board.

16 Sec. 08.12.310. FAILURE TO PASS OR APPLY FOR AN APPRENTICE EX-  
17 AMINATION. An applicant who has failed an apprentice examination or  
18 fails to apply for an examination within two years of the time he  
19 graduates from an approved barber college or from the time he completes  
20 the educational requirements specified by the board must re-enroll in  
21 an approved barber college or pass further courses specified by the  
22 board.

23 Sec. 08.12.320. QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSE TO PRACTICE BARBERING.

24 A person is qualified to be licensed to practice barbering if he

25 (1) has met the requirements of secs. 70, 300 and 330 of  
26 this chapter;

27 (2) has served as an apprentice barber for not less than  
28 one year under the immediate personal supervision of a licensed barber  
29 in this state; and

(3) has passed an examination prescribed by the board.

Sec. 08.12.325. FAILURE TO PASS EXAMINATION. If an applicant does not pass the examination prescribed by the board, he must practice for six months as an apprentice barber before he may apply for another examination.

Sec. 08.12.330. AFFIDAVIT AND REQUIREMENT OF SERVICE OF APPRENTICESHIP. An apprentice barber shall file an affidavit signed by the licensed supervising barber with the board at the end of each six months of apprenticeship for a one year period. A licensed barber shall not supervise more than one apprentice barber at a time. No apprentice barber shall be allowed to barber for more than three years on an apprentice barber license. The board may revoke or suspend the license of a licensed barber who refuses to sign a true affidavit, and may sign the affidavit in the place of the barber. An apprentice barber who does not file the affidavit may not take the examination.

\* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1968.
