6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that drivers' licenses be sufficient
7 for proof of age as regards the liquor laws."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.065. DRIVER'S LICENSE AS PROOF OF AGE. An Alaska
11 driver's license shall be acceptable as proof of age when used for
12 identification in the purchase of liquor and for presence in estab-
13 lishments where liquor is sold. The liquor licensee shall not be held
14 liable for any of the penalties imposed for serving minors or permitting
15 minors on the premises when a driver's license indicates that the
16 owner and possessor thereof is 21 years of age or over.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect only upon the amending of AS 28.15 to
18 require the showing of a birth certificate in the application for an opera-
19 tor's license and to require a photograph on the operator's license.
