6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that drivers' licenses be sufficient  
7 for proof of age as regards the liquor laws."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.065. DRIVER'S LICENSE AS PROOF OF AGE. An Alaska  
11 driver's license shall be acceptable as proof of age when used for  
12 identification in the purchase of liquor and for presence in establish-  
13 ments where liquor is sold if the license is made of or encased in  
14 plastic and contains a photograph of the license holder and a statement  
15 of his age or date of birth. The liquor licensee shall not be held  
16 liable for any of the penalties imposed for serving minors or permittin  
17 minors on the premises when a driver's license indicates that the owner  
18 and possessor of the license is 21 years of age or over.
