6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that drivers' licenses be sufficient
7 for proof of age as regards the liquor laws."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.065. DRIVER'S LICENSE AS PROOF OF AGE. A valid
11 Alaska driver's license shall be acceptable as proof of age when used
12 for identification in the purchase of liquor and for presence in
13 establishments where liquor is sold if the license is made of or
14 encased in plastic and contains a photograph of the license holder
15 and a statement of his age or date of birth. The liquor licensee shall
16 not be held liable for any of the penalties imposed for serving minors
17 or permitting minors on the premises when such a driver's license
18 indicates that the owner and possessor of the license is 21 years of
19 age or over.
