6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for uniform time; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 01 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 15. TIME

11 Sec. 01.15.010. STANDARD TIME. (a) The time zones specified in  
12 the Federal Uniform Time Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-387; 80 Stat. 107;  
13 15 U.S.C. 260 to 267) as applying to Alaska are the sixth, seventh and  
14 eighth zones, based, respectively, on the mean solar time of the 135th,  
15 the 150th and the 165th degree of longitude west from Greenwich. These  
16 are known as Yukon standard time, Alaska-Hawaii standard time and  
17 Bering standard time, respectively.

18 (b) All departments of the state government and all boroughs,  
19 cities, towns and villages shall use the appropriate standard of time  
20 prescribed in (a) of this section.

21 (c) All persons operating or maintaining places of business or  
22 engaged in business activity shall use the appropriate standard of time  
23 prescribed in (a) of this section.

24 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
25 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
