6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to qualifications of the members of
7 the assembly of an organized borough."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 07.20.050 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 07.20.050. QUALIFICATIONS. A person is eligible to be a
11 member of the assembly if he is a qualified voter of the borough.
12 Additional residency requirements not to exceed three years may be
13 prescribed by ordinance for members of the assembly elected from the
14 area outside first class cities. If a member of the assembly ceases'
15 to be a qualified voter of the borough, he shall immediately forfeit
16 his office. If a member elected from the area outside first class
17 cities becomes a resident of a first class city or becomes a resident
18 of a borough election section in the area outside first class cities
19 other than the section from which he was elected, he shall immediately
20 forfeit his office [HE MAY CONTINUE TO SERVE ONLY UNTIL THE NEXT
21 REGULAR ELECTION].

22 * Sec. 2. AS 07.25.010 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 07.25.010. EXECUTIVE POWER. The executive power of the
24 organized borough is vested in the borough chairman who is elected at
25 large. He must be a qualified voter of the area encompassed by the
26 boundaries of the organized borough. Additional residency requirements
27 not to exceed three years may be prescribed by ordinance for the
28 borough chairman. His term of office is the same as that of the mayor
29 in the largest first class city in the borough or three years if there

1 is no first class city in the borough. The term of office begins on
2 the same day as that of the mayor in the largest first class city in
3 the borough or on the first Monday following his election if there
4 is no first class city in the borough. The assembly may provide a
5 different term by ordinance.
