6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the levying of special assessments
7 for local improvements by cities and organized
8 boroughs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.10.297 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 29.10.297. STREET, WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS BY DISTRICTS.

12 In cities of the first class, the council, by general ordinance or
13 special ordinance or both may create and maintain street, water and
14 sewer improvement districts, and establish, change and revise their
15 boundaries from time to time; erect, build, establish, lay out, alter,
16 open, improve and repair streets, sewers, water supply and distribution
17 systems, avenues, sidewalks, alleys, bridges, squares and other public
18 highways and places within the city, and drain, sprinkle and light
19 them, remove all obstructions; establish grades; grade, plank, pave,
20 macadamize, gravel and curb them, in whole or in part, and construct
21 gutters, culverts, sidewalks and crosswalks, and levy, apportion,
22 assess and collect the cost or any part of it against and from the
23 property within the improvement district. The council may determine
24 what work shall be done or improvements made at the expense, in whole or
25 in part, of the owners of the adjoining, contiguous or proximate
26 property, or noncontiguous and other properties within an improvement
27 district specially benefited thereby, and provide for the manner of
28 making, apportioning, and collecting assessments therefor. The govern-
29 ing body may levy assessments authorized in this section irrespective
