6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the levying of special assessments  
7 for local improvements by cities and organized  
8 boroughs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 29.10.246 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 29.10.246. ASSESSMENTS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AGAINST PROPERTY  
12 BENEFITED. The council may assess against the real property specially  
13 benefited by the improvements all or part [TWO-THIRDS] of the cost of  
14 laying out, grading, constructing or repairing a street, alley or  
15 sidewalk, constructing or repairing a sewer or drain, constructing or  
16 repairing water supply and distribution systems, acquiring and con-  
17 structing parks or playgrounds or making changes in channels of streams  
18 or watercourses or constructing, erecting, strengthening or repairing  
19 bulkheads, embankments or dikes for streams or watercourses. The costs  
20 shall be assessed against the real property specially benefited in  
21 proportion to the benefits received by each tract of land. However,  
22 no assessment may be levied for an improvement unless the improvement  
23 is requested of the city council in writing by the owners of at least  
24 one-half in value of the property to be specially benefited by the  
25 improvement. The expense assessed may include the cost to the city  
26 of acquiring premises for the improvements.
