6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to highway surveys and construction."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 19.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 19.10.260. REPLACEMENT OF PERMANENT MARKERS AND FILING OF  
10 RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP AFTER CONSTRUCTION. The department shall:

11 (1) replace all permanent markers on private or municipal  
12 property that were destroyed or lost during highway construction, to  
13 permit persons to accurately determine new boundary lines resulting  
14 from the construction;

15 (2) file in the local recording district, after completion  
16 of highway construction, an accurate right-of-way map that will  
17 contain engineering and survey information to enable a private land  
18 owner or a municipal engineer to ascertain where the resulting  
19 boundary lines are located on private or municipal property along the  
20 highway.
