6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the treatment of special education
7 pupils under the Public School Foundation Act; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.17.050(d) is amended to read:

11 (d) Each district is entitled to the number of teacher units for
12 elementary schools which corresponds to the average daily membership
13 for its elementary schools in the following elementary schedule. Each
14 district is entitled to the number of teacher units for secondary
15 schools which corresponds to the average daily membership for its
16 secondary schools in the following secondary schedule. If a school
17 district has two or more secondary attendance centers, it shall
18 separately compute the allowable number of teacher units for each of
19 its secondary attendance centers which has an average daily membership
20 of 301 or more pupils. Each district is entitled to the number of
21 teacher units for special education which corresponds to the average
22 daily membership for its special education program in the following
23 special education schedule.

2 Sec. 14.17.110. COMPUTATION OF AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP ALLOT-
3 MENT. The average daily membership allotment of each district is
4 computed as required by sec. 60 of this chapter, except that

5 (1) the estimated average daily membership as defined by
6 sec. 90 of this chapter is used in place of average daily membership;
7 and

8 (2) each exceptional child receiving special services is
9 counted as two pupils.

10 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1967.
