6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the treatment of special education
7 pupils under the Public School Foundation Act; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.17.050(d) is amended to read:

11 (d) Each district is entitled to the number of teacher units for
12 elementary schools which corresponds to the average daily membership
13 for its elementary schools in the following elementary schedule. Each
14 district is entitled to the number of teacher units for secondary
15 schools which corresponds to the average daily membership for its
16 secondary schools in the following secondary schedule. If a school
17 district has two or more secondary attendance centers, it shall
18 separately compute the allowable number of teacher units for each of
19 its secondary attendance centers which has an average daily member-
20 ship of 301 or more pupils. Each district is entitled to the number
21 of teacher units for special education which corresponds to the
22 average daily membership for its special education program in the
23 following special education schedule.

3 exceptional child receiving special services, except as provided in
4 (d) of this section, is counted as two pupils.

5 (d) In computing the allotment under this section, each
6 physically handicapped child receiving special services is counted as
7 three pupils.

8 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1967.
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
