6 For an Act entitled: "An act relating to service of process on nonresident
7 motorists."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.05.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The operation of a motor vehicle by a nonresident (or owned
11 by a nonresident and operated by his express or implied consent) [ON
12 A PUBLIC HIGHWAY] in the state is considered equivalent to an appoint-
13 ment of the commissioner of revenue by the nonresident as his attorney.
14 The summons may be served on the commissioner in an action against the
15 nonresident growing out of an accident or collision in which the
16 vehicle is involved while being so operated. This operation is con-
17 sidered a signification of the nonresident's agreement that a summons
18 against him which is so served has the same legal force as if served
19 on him personally in the state.
