6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the composition of the assembly
7 of an organized borough."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 07.20.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 07.20.020. ELECTION AND APPOINTMENT. Members of the assembly
11 are [APPOINTED OR] elected according to the apportionment determined by
12 the incorporation petition approved by the voters until the assembly is
13 reapportioned. Assemblymen representing a first class city are directly
14 elected by city voters to dual council-assembly seats. The council
15 shall designate by ordinance those council seats which are to be dual
16 council-assembly seats. The designation shall be clearly indicated on
17 the ballot. Assemblymen representing the area outside first class
18 cities are elected from and by the voters residing outside the first
19 class cities. The present terms of city councilman serving on borough
20 assemblies are not affected by this section [MEMBERS REPRESENTING FIRST
21 CLASS CITIES ARE APPOINTED BY AND FROM THE CITY COUNCILS, UNLESS
22 PROVIDED OTHERWISE BY CITY CHARTER OR ORDINANCE. MEMBERS REPRESENTING
23 THE AREA OUTSIDE FIRST CLASS CITIES ARE ELECTED].
