6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the residency requirements for
7 blind persons seeking assistance; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.25.780(4) is amended to read:

11 (4) "needy blind resident" means a needy blind person 18
12 years of age or over, who has resided in the state for one year [FIVE
13 OUT OF THE LAST NINE YEARS] immediately preceding application for
14 assistance, or who has lost his vision while a resident of the state;
15 provided, that if the state in which a person resided immediately be-
16 fore moving to Alaska permits welfare assistance to needy blind
17 Alaskans moving to that state before the expiration of a year or any
18 lesser period of time, that person may qualify as a "needy blind
19 resident" after residing in Alaska for a period of time equal to the
20 period of residency required by his former state.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
