5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for a free community college
7 education for certain residents of the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 ARTICLE 9. COLLEGE PROGRAM

11 Sec. 14.40.750. FREE COLLEGE PROGRAM. (a) The state shall
12 provide for two years of a degree program college education at a state
13 funded community college for all qualified persons.

14 (b) A qualified person is a resident of the state who is under
15 21 years of age, has successfully completed the 12th grade, and who
16 meets the admission requirements of the community college.

17 (c) A qualified person shall be admitted to any state owned and
18 operated community college where facilities are available without
19 regard to the area of the state in which he resides.

20 (d) Tuition and books shall be provided by the state free of
21 charge to the student.
