6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the lien for work done or
7 materials furnished; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 34.35.050 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 34.35.050. LIEN FOR WORK DONE OR MATERIALS FURNISHED. A
12 person or firm, contractor, lumber merchant, architect, engineer, de-
13 signer, mechanic, artisan, machinist, tradesman, plumber, electrician,
14 carpenter, painter, laborer, teamster, drayman, equipment rental
15 operator, or other person performing design or supervision services or
16 performing labor upon or preliminary to the construction of, or furnish-
17 ing material, or renting, leasing, or otherwise supplying equipment to
18 be used in the construction of, or furnishing material, or renting,
19 leasing or otherwise supplying equipment for the construction of, or
20 furnishing material for the construction, alteration, or repair,
21 either in whole or in part of a building, wharf, bridge, flume, fence,
22 machinery, aqueduct, well, or land clearing, or a structure or super-
23 structure, including the clearing, grading, draining, excavating or
24 landscaping of the ground upon which it is constructed, and the in-
25 stallation of sewer and water lines in it has a lien on it for the
26 work done or material furnished at the instance of the owner of the
27 building or other improvement, or his agent.

28 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
29 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
