6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the powers of designated judicial
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 22.20.035. POWERS OF JUDICIAL EMPLOYEES. The clerk of a
11 court, and a deputy clerk designated by order of a court, may exercise
12 the powers of judicial officers specified in (4), (5), (6) and (7) of
13 sec. 30 of this chapter, and other powers authorized by law.

14 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
15 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
