6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing organized boroughs to prohibit
7 political signs along public thoroughfares for
8 certain periods of time."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 07.15.340(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The first and second class borough has the responsibility of
12 planning, platting, and zoning on an areawide basis and shall do so in
13 the manner provided for first class cities, except as otherwise provided
14 in this section. The [THAT THE] planning commission shall also be the
15 zoning commission. Nothing in this section prevents any city from
16 having a planning and zoning commission in an advisory capacity.
17 Appointment of borough planning and zoning commission members from a
18 first class city shall be made from the city advisory commission
19 membership.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 07.15.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

21 (c) The assembly may by ordinance prohibit the erection of
22 political signs along public roads and highways, except that, subject
23 to reasonable regulation, political signs which do not exceed four by
24 eight feet shall be permitted for the period commencing 30 days before
25 the state primary election and ending 15 days after the state general
26 election and for a period commencing 30 days before and ending 15 days
27 after a borough or city election (including all run-off elections).
