6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the meaning of an Alaska bidder
7 and providing for setting aside of certain contracts
8 for small business concerns."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 37.05.230(5) is amended to read:

11 (5) an "Alaska bidder," for the purpose of bid awards under
12 (1)(B) of this section, is a person, firm or corporation that [WHO]

13 (A) holds a current Alaska business license,

14 (B) submits a bid for goods or services under the name

15 as appearing on his current Alaska business license,

16 (C) has maintained a place of business within the
17 state for a period of six months immediately preceding the date
18 of his bid,

19 (D) is 80 per cent or more owned by residents of the
20 state.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 37.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

22 Sec. 37.05.232. CONTRACTS SET ASIDE FOR SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.

23 All contracts to be awarded under this chapter that have a value of less
24 than \$100,000 as determined by the estimates of the contracting depart-
25 ment or agency shall be set aside for exclusive participation by small
26 business concerns as defined in this chapter. This section shall not
27 apply when its application would disqualify the state from receiving
28 federal-aid funds.
